
Very pleased I contacted David and we started this long lasting relationship and friendship.





16km — by car: 32km







The property was donated to the City of Louisville and dedicated as a park in 1977. It is registered as being just 0.03 acre (1,300 square feet) in size. The property once belonged to Frank and Mary Gnadinger who had built a house on the property at 1027 Ellison Avenue in 1923.











ARMS OF GNÄDINGER



The black ram in golden yellow background represents the strength and the leadership talent of the first Gnädinger. The gray helmet with yellow-gold and black plume was the symbol of the aristocratic war necks of Habsburg anno 1403.

With the elevation in the knighthood the golden crown was awarded with the three prongs; the black G was the award of the Council of Constance to the God-fearing families.

In the Zurich War of 1447 it was seen for the first time the complete coat of arms and banners in the Confederation.

It is said that the name and arms come originally from Bachsee, Tirol, Austria
